Stepping down from lead teacher position

After 50 years of Suzuki violin teaching and the last 4 years functioning as WDSS's Lead Teacher, **Mrs. B** will be stepping back. Zachary Ragent will be assuming the Lead Teacher position.

Mrs. B, known then as Laurie Cressman, began her musical journey in Lexington, Kentucky when she was introduced to the viola in the fourth grade. Spurred on by a strong youth orchestra and private teaching, she decided to go into music education. While earning her degree at the University of Kentucky she became fascinated with the Suzuki Method. She spent many Saturdays sitting in the corner of a classroom as she watched former student of Dr Suzuki, Kazue Baber, teach the very young students. One day when Ms. Baber was ill and not able to teach, one of the parents said, 'Why don't you teach this class?" She did and was hooked.



In 1972 Mrs. B. attended the Stevens Point in Wisconsin, a Suzuki Institute as a student assistant and spent all her time observing. That fall she began teaching for Lexington Talent Education Association. In 1973, during a brief stay in Virginia, she started a Suzuki Program at Old Dominion University. She has maintained a private studio since then in

both Kentucky and Colorado, with some short times off to tend to her growing family. Over the years Mrs. B has also run summer music camps starting with a single quartet and growing to a full arts camp of 110 students.
